ISLO: Institutional student learning outcome

GESLO: General education student learning outcome

PSLO: Program student learning outcome

Course completion: Percentage of student enrollments that do not withdraw from a class and receive a valid grade in a credit course

Course success: Percentage of student enrollments that receive a passing/satisfactory grade in a credit course

Graduation rate: Among first-time cohort credit students, proportion who earned a degree or certificate from Southwestern College within three years of starting at the college

Transfer rate: Among first-time cohort credit students, proportion who enrolled in any four-year postsecondary institution within four years of enrolling at Southwestern College
