







The creation of six peer college groups is based on a linear regression analysis utilizing three "environmental" variables and correlated to the Student Success Scorecard's Completion/SPAR outcome.

- **High School Academic Performance by College Index (API)**: Index created by the CCC Chancellor's Office, it assigns a weighted API to each college in proportion to high school student enrollments (based on Fall 2008 data)
- **Bachelors Plus Index (BA+)**: Within the college's service area population, the proportion of persons with a bachelors degree or higher. Based on Census Bureau American Community Survey data.
- Percent of students age 25 and over: Based on Fall 2008 CCC Chancellor's Office MIS data.
