



- Asian and Filipino students 70.4%, 69.8%


Scorecard Completion Rates are **LOWEST** among:

Southwestern College Scorecard Completion Rate, 5 Year Summary




Change in % Prepared Students Over the Last 5 Years



Subgroup Counts Within Starting Cohort










2015 Peer Group Comparison: Completion, College Unprepared










The Completion Pathway, Overall



The Completion Pathway, Prepared




The Completion Pathway, Unprepared




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
2015 Peer Group Comparison: 30-Units, Overall




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2015 Peer Group Comparison: Remedial, English






2015 Peer Group Comparison: Remedial, Math





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

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
Changes Statewide: Funding
